

Dual Enrollment

We encourage our eligible students to pursue Dual Enrollment partnerships with Atlanta Technical College and Georgia Military College. Our students have had great success in both programs and have earned free college credit. We are proud of our students who have graduated from HCCA prepared to enter the workforce from Atlanta Technical College and of our students who have graduated with Associate's Degrees from Georgia Military College.

We provide transportation to Georgia Military College and Atlanta Technical College daily. Most classes are held off campus, but we do accommodate dual enrollment classes on campus.

Students who meet the necessary requirements may begin Dual Enrollment in the ninth grade. However, the decision to begin Dual Enrollment should not be entered lightly. Students are enrolled in college and must fulfill all collegiate requirements. Students should be self-motivated, eager to learn, willing to work hard, and responsible.
