Georgia Milestones Assessments (GMAS)

GMAS 2021 is here!!! While only a few students opted into testing, the faculty and staff are committed to preparing each student to be successful on the standards assessed by the GMAS. For the remainder of the school year, daily instruction will include an intense review of tested standards. *To ensure learning continues for students not testing, we will observe asynchronous learning days by content areas. Students should join live instruction for every teacher as scheduled except the day the teacher's content area is being tested.* See the testing dates and asynchronous learning days for each content area below. Additional testing information will be sent directly to parents and students who opted into testing.

• Summer Learning Opportunity #1 – Summer School

Student Eligibility	Any student who earned an Incomplete for 1st or 2nd Semester or failed math, literacy, science, or social studies for the year will be eligible.
