Beginning the week of August 24th, we will welcome students back for the new school year. As you know, the past six months have proved to be a challenge, with COVID-19 closing our physical doors in March. Thankfully we've been able to pivot without pause, providing an enriched virtual program for our students, knowing it is our duty to ensure that every child in our district receives the support and resources they need to thrive academically. The importance of this work is even greater as Future Foundation is moving forward with remote learning through the end of the calendar year. The below bullet points provide an overview of our fall virtual programming services:

- Provide remote learning support with reading, math, tutoring and homework.
- Coordinate with teachers to address special areas of learning loss and to help students who are struggling.
- Develop caseloads of students to conduct informal check-ins.
- Partner with schools to distribute meals to families.
- Provide positive youth development and social and emotional activities.
- Offer parents a virtual parent studio to foster family engagement and support.

Prior to the start of this semester, we'd like to share some results from our spring and summer virtual programming to give you an overview of what Future Foundation has been doing as well as to let you know what we need from our community moving forward.

Since March, the Future Foundation team has provided over 7,000 meals to 213 individuals, and over 900 hours of academic and social emotional support to 281 students.

Even with those positive outcomes, we know that there is even more we can do to close the education gap during these troubling times. We know that there are more students that would benefit from our programming. To further develop our partnership, we would love to help the following:

- Identify students who need our services.
- Assign a point of contact to work with our staff.
- Schedule a monthly check-in to do discuss the caseload of students from your school we service.
- Identify additional needs your school might have that Future Foundation can support.
